Mon., April 30 -

Depart Denver, CO to Santa Fe, NM.

I-25 S with possible detour at either Walsenburg or Raton weather depending. Lunch in Taos. - 392 miles (5 hrs, 43 mins w/o detours)

Tues., May 1 -

Depart Santa Fe, NM to Flagstaff, AZ.

I-25 S to Albuquerque, I-40 W to Flagstaff.

Lunch in Gallup, NM. - 384 miles (5 hrs, 34 mins)

Weds., May 2 -

Depart Flagstaff, AZ to Las Vegas, NV.

I-40 W to 93 N.

Lunch TBD, maybe Lake Mead, or push to Vegas. - 249 miles (3 hrs, 45 mins)

Weds., May 2 - Sat., May 5, 2018 NVE3 Las Vegas

Sat., May 5 -

Depart Las Vegas, NV to Moab, UT. I-15 N to I-70 E.

Lunch TBD. - 457 miles (6 hrs, 30 mins)

Sun., May 6 -

Depart Moab, UT to Denver, CO. I-70 E.

Lunch TBD. - 354 miles (5 hrs, 24 mins)
